

Schedule “A” to Facility Rental Agreement dated _____

Between

The Township of Asphodel-Norwood (“Township”)

and

_____ (“Organization/Group Coordinator”)

Specific Conditions Related to Infectious Diseases including COVID-19

In addition to The Township of Asphodel-Norwood (the “Township”) Standard Terms and Conditions contained in the Facility Rental Agreement (the “Agreement”), the undersigned, acting as representative for and acting on behalf of the Organization/Group Coordinator, has read, understands, and agrees to the following Additional Terms and Conditions. The Organization/Group Coordinator will abide by the Additional Terms and Conditions contained herein, as well as the Terms and Conditions in the Facility Rental Agreement:

1. The following individuals are not permitted to attend or participate in the event (collectively referred to as “Prohibited Persons”):
 - a. Anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 and who has not been deemed by health authorities to have recovered from COVID-19;
 - b. Anyone who is sick with any illness or has any symptom associated with COVID-19, including fever, cough, tiredness, aches and pains, nasal congestion, sore throat, diarrhea, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, headache, chest pain/pressure, loss of taste or smell, discoloration of fingers or toes, or loss of speech or movement;
 - c. Anyone who has returned from traveling outside of Canada in the past 14 days; or,
 - d. Anyone who knows or believes that they may have been exposed in the past 14 days to: a person who has symptoms of COVID-19; or a person who has tested positive for COVID-19.
2. The Organization/Group Coordinator is responsible for ensuring that no Prohibited Person attends or participates in the event.
3. The Organization/Group Coordinator will comply with all applicable Provincial Orders, Provincial and Regional Public Health directives and guidelines. This includes, if applicable: return to sports protocols and guidelines issued by the Organization’s national and/or provincial sport organization regarding COVID-19.
4. The Agreement may be revoked or certain restrictions may be imposed by the Province, the Township, or other authorities that could result in cancellation or limitation of the Organization/Group Coordinator’s use of the Facility, including limitations on attendance, depending on the COVID-19 pandemic situation.

5. The Organization/Group Coordinator agrees to:
 - a. abide by their governing body and/or Organization's established health and safety protocols during the use of the Facility and, upon request, provide the Township with copies of said protocols during the Term;
 - b. ensure all attendees wear a mask whenever they are not actively engaged in a physical activity. For example, this means a mask must be worn while in the lobby, travelling to other areas in the facility, if you're the coach, if you are a spectator, etc.;
 - c. ensure any person who enters the Facility for the purposes of participating in or attending the event maintains a physical distance of at least 2 metres from any other person, subject to all applicable Provincial Orders, Provincial and Regional Public Health directives and guidelines;
 - d. take attendance during the event, while the Facility is being used;
 - e. shall maintain the records created under 5(d) for the purpose of contact tracing in the event of a COVID-19 outbreak;
 - f. encourage each attendee to bring their own equipment and/or supplies, and ensure it's being used as a single use only or being sanitized between each use; and,
 - g. sanitize and disinfect any touch items prior to and after use and inform anyone using the Facility that the amenities are not sanitized regularly by the Township and they need to take appropriate measures to avoid infection from high touch surfaces.
6. The Township is not responsible for and will not be cleaning, sanitizing, or disinfecting any touch points during events. This includes but is not limited to picnic tables, benches, sport equipment, tables, doors, etc.
7. Any activity that is likely to result in people being unable to maintain a 2 metre physical distance is not permitted, subject to all applicable Provincial Orders, Provincial and Regional Public Health directives and guidelines.
8. Change rooms will only be available for indoor Community Centre bookings and need to be prearranged at time of booking. One (1) change room will be made available, per booking, to be used for first aid and washroom purposes. Access to the change room is for players only.
9. Designated areas will be marked for individuals needing to get ready, waiting, etc. Please note that all players should come dressed in gear as much as possible. The Organization/Group Coordinator agrees to inform their attendees of the following regulations:
 - a. entrance to the facility is through the front doors;
 - b. the lobby is closed and there should be no loitering in the area;
 - c. hand sanitizing stations are located throughout the facility;

- d. to access the lobby washrooms, you will need to request a key from the duty operator/attendant;
 - e. one (1) parent/guardian is permitted per player, for U13 groups only;
 - f. a limit of 5 parents/guardians are allowed in the hallway at one time, while team members are getting ready;
 - g. if your players are assigned the lobby end to get ready, you will utilize sections 3 & 4 of the viewing area. If your players are assigned the Zamboni end to get ready, you will utilize sections 5 & 6 of the viewing area;
 - h. attendees in sections 3 & 4 (lobby end) will exit between rooms 1 & 2, while attendees in sections 5 & 6 (Zamboni end) will exit through the far door located at the end of the hall; and,
 - i. the concession will remain closed until game time.
10. Obtaining permission to use the Facility for the purpose of engaging in group activities or events presents various risks, including the risk of exposure to COVID-19 and other infectious diseases. The Organization/Group Coordinator voluntarily assumes any and all risks associated with exposure to COVID-19, which risks include but are not limited to the risk of personal injury, illness, and death, which the Permit Holder, its participants/players, and any other attendees of the event may be exposed to by using the Facility.
