

Tuesday January 12, 2021

- Council directed staff to provide Municipal Appraisal Forms to the County of Peterborough Land Division for Consent applications B-76-20 (R. English) and B-77-20 (K. English);
- The Mayor and Clerk were directed to execute an amended Preliminary Development Agreement between the Township of Asphodel-Norwood and 1087086 Ontario Inc. for the proposed Wellington Street development;
- Council approved the 2021 Operating & Capital Budget with a **0.68%** municipal tax rate increase (which equates to a \$0.60 monthly tax rate increase for the **municipal tax portion** on an average property in the Township);
- Council approved the 2021 Norwood Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budgets with a \$0.09/m³ **decrease** on the Variable Rate and a \$1.69 **decrease** on the monthly Fixed Rate for the Norwood Water System; and a \$0.02/m³ **decrease** on the Variable Rate and a \$0.64 **decrease** on the Fixed Rate for the Norwood Sewer System, allowing for zero impact on the tax base for both systems;
- Council approved the 2021 Trentview Estates Water Operating and Capital Budget with a \$0.04 increase on the Variable Rate (in alignment with the municipality of Trent Hills), a \$0.38 **decrease** on the monthly pipe charge (transfer of cost from the municipality of Trent Hills), and a \$0.05 increase in the monthly Fixed Rate for the Trentview Estates Water System;
- CAO/Clerk/Treasurer White gave an update on the Centre Line Road Reconstruction Project (targeted to commence May 1, 2021) and a COVID-19 departmental update to Council;
- Dr. Salvaterra, Medical Officer of Health, for Peterborough Public Health (PPH) is presenting an update on the COVID-19 vaccines on Friday January 15, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. Residents may register for the virtual event or watch the event live on PPH's [YouTube channel](#);
- Deputy Mayor Burt and CAO/Clerk/Treasurer White will be in attendance for the 2021 Rural Ontario Municipal Association (ROMA) virtual conference being held over January 25-26, 2021; and
