

## Tuesday January 28, 2020

- The Township CAO/Clerk/Treasurer provided Council with an itemized statement of remuneration and expenses paid to members of Council in 2019
- Council approved the proposed 2020 Fees & Charges By-Law with the passing of By-Law 2020-05
  - A 1% rental fee increase was adopted for social events at the Millennium Room, Norwood Town Hall, and Recreation Complex (Baseball Diamond)
  - A 2% rental fee increase was adopted for recreational sessions at the Community Centre (Public skating, Norwood Minor Hockey, Norwood Figure Skating, Prime ice time, Day ice time, Hockey Skills Academy, Norwood & District Sports tournaments, and Minor Sports organizations (outside of Asphodel-Norwood))
  - A \$50 fee (per hour/per person) and a \$100 fee (per hour/per truck) was introduced for Non-Emergency Fire Call-Outs
  - Double fines were introduced in the Fire Department for repeat violations of the same offence of the Burn By-law or the Fees & Charges By-law at the same address or by the same person committing the act
- Council received the annual Building Financial Report for 2019 and approved the allocation of the 2019 Building Department surplus to the Building Department Reserves
- Council directed staff to submit correspondence to the County of Peterborough proposing a cost-sharing venture for a paved shoulder extension for a pedestrian walkway from County Road 45 to Old Orchard Road to fully complete the County Road 45 Urbanization & Resurfacing Project
- The Asphodel-Norwood Trails Committee will be meeting shortly to commence planning for Trails Day 2020
- The Asphodel-Norwood Cultural and Heritage Committee will be building all their events in 2020 around the 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Township of Asphodel
- The Township website address has changed to [www.antownship.ca](http://www.antownship.ca) – the old domain will remain active to re-route visitors for one year
- Township staff met with the CEO/Librarian on January 27, 2020 to kick-off renovation planning for the Asphodel-Norwood Public Library (Norwood branch) outdoor space (made possible through the successful Rural Economic Development (RED) cost-sharing initiative from the provincial government)
- 2020 Interim Tax Bills will be mailed out in February
- The winter remedial work for sanitary laterals on Maple Ave East has been completed with a comprehensive, detailed project document to follow and monitoring to continue in the Spring
- An International Women's Day event will be held on Sunday March 8, 2020 at the Norwood Town Hall from 11:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.
