



Township of Asphodel-Norwood Council Meeting Highlights

Tuesday October 15, 2019

- 2019 3rd Quarter reports were shared from the Fire & Rescue, Building, By-Law, Parks, Recreation & Facilities, and Water & Wastewater departments
- Council received a deputation from the Peterborough County Engineering & Design Manager and Coordinator requesting feedback on the County's Sign By-Law with respect to signage placed within the County road allowance and private property adjacent to County roads
- Council adopted the 2020-2024 Public Works Surface Treatment Plan
- Council authorized a merger agreement between 1087086 Ontario Inc. (BGS Homes) and the Corporation of the Township of Asphodel-Norwood with the passing of By-Law 2019-53
- Further to the pilot project undertaken at the Transfer Station, Council directed staff to adjust the operating hours to:
Mondays: 8:00 am to Noon (Year round)
Wednesdays: 4:00 pm to 7:30 pm (May 1 – October 1)
Saturdays: 8:00 am to 2:00 pm (Year round)
- Council authorized a merger agreement between Robert Gordon Steele & Tammy Lynn Steel and the Corporation of the Township of Asphodel-Norwood with the passing of By-Law 2019-52
- Council directed staff to submit the draft Cemetery By-Law update to the Registrar of the Funeral, Burial, and Cremation Services Act for approval
- Council authorized staff to submit an application to the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) – Community, Culture, and Recreation funding stream for an expansion to the Asphodel-Norwood Community Centre for a health club that would be 74% funded if approved
- Council directed staff to update the Council Compensation By-Law effective January 1, 2020
- Council received draft 2020 budget reports for the Planning & Economic Development, Fire, Transportation, and Environmental Services departments
- Council expressed gratitude to staff, the Economic Development & Beautification Advisory Committee, and the Norwood Agricultural Society for their support in making the Asphodel-Norwood Cultural and Heritage Committee's inaugural scarecrow challenge a Township wide success
- Council was reminded of the Asphodel-Norwood Cultural and Heritage Committee's upcoming Trees and Twilight festival
