



Township of Asphodel-Norwood Council Meeting Highlights

Tuesday November 26, 2019

- Council received an update on Tourism Wayfinding from Peterborough and Kawartha's Economic Development and endorsed the Tourism Wayfinding System in principle for consideration in the 2020 budget
- Council recommended approval of Consent Application B-69-19 for a technical lot addition
- Council authorized a facility lease agreement at 1818 Asphodel 3rd Line with G. C. Duke Equipment Ltd with the passing of By-Law 2019-61
- Council received draft 2020 budget reports for the Parks and Recreation departments
- Council authorized the following name additions to the Township Street Name Registry: Archer, Almira, Bradley (as submitted by the Developer), Finlay, Fraser, Grover, Henry, Keeler, Mary Ann (as submitted by the Developer), Oliver, and Pearce
- Council recommended Street A be named Keeler Court in the Norwood Park Phase 3 Subdivision
- Council recommended Street B be named Fraser Lane in the Norwood Park Phase 3 Subdivision
- Council recommended Street C be named Bradley Lane in the Norwood Park Phase 3 Subdivision
- Council recommended Street D be named Oliver Lane in the Norwood Park Phase 3 Subdivision
- Council recommended Finlay Court as the alternate name for Street A in the Norwood Park Phase 3 Subdivision
- Council recommended Mary Ann Lane as the alternate name for Street B, C, or D in the Norwood Park Phase 3 Subdivision
- Council supported the Christmas Day Dinner Committee's donation request for relief of facility rental fees at the Town Hall on December 25, 2019
- The Township's 2019 Interim Audit was completed with no concerns raised over November 18 and 19, 2019
- Curbside collection on Rogers Lane and Maguire Road will commence the week December 2, 2019
- Council authorized the CAO/Clerk/Treasurer to submit an application for Modernization Funding to support the 2020 service delivery review project
- Council directed staff to prepare a telecommunications policy
