- 2019 4th Quarter reports were shared from the Fire & Rescue, Building, By-Law, Parks, Recreation & Facilities, and Water & Wastewater Departments
- Council received a deputation from the James Bidgood Memorial Day Committee requesting continued support for their 5th annual event, along with any suggestions Council could offer on local community groups that could benefit from a portion of their fundraising dollars
- Council received the Drinking Water Quality Management Standard (DWQMS) Surveillance Audit and Accreditation for the village of Norwood and Trentview Estates drinking water systems
- Council declared the Public Works 2006 International Tandem Plow Truck equipped with Viking Cives plow equipment as surplus. The truck will be auctioned on www.govdeals.ca with a reserve bid of \$20,000.00
- Council authorized staff to advertise the Township's draft Telecommunication Tower Policy for a 30-day public commenting period
- Council supported a donation request from the Peterborough County Plowmen's Association
- Council supported a donation request from the James Bidgood Memorial Day Committee
- Council accepted a proposal from the County of Peterborough regarding a paved shoulder to extend a pedestrian walkway on County Road 45 from the sidewalk at the village of Hastings limits to Old Orchard Road
- Council entered into a public meeting to consider an application for a Zoning By-Law Amendment for 49 Alma Street, Norwood and supported the amendment with the passing of By-Law 2020-10
- A date for the annual Trails Day event in the Township of Asphodel-Norwood has been set for Saturday June 6, 2020
- Council passed a resolution to participate in the County of Peterborough's RFP to hire a new integrity commissioner; and appointed John Mascarin of Aird & Berlis LLP as the temporary interim integrity commissioner
- Interim tax bills will be mailed out the week of Family Day
- Council approved the proposed 2020 Fees & Charges By-Law with the passing of By-Law 2020-11
 - The cost for a composter increased by \$5.00
 - The cost for a blue box increased by \$1.00
 - The cost for a digester (with the County incentive) increased by \$10.00
 - A Telecommunication Tower Submission fee was added in the amount of \$250.00 per submission
