

Tuesday May 12, 2020

- Council received the final report on the Clean Water Wastewater Fund project
- Staff provided Council with an update on the Mill Street Bridge rehabilitation plan following the results of a detailed bridge deck condition survey. The engineering survey recommends replacement within the next five years rather than rehabilitation, so staff will be exploring cost effective alternatives in the interim
- Council received a report regarding the purchase of a Black Cat radar detection system as detailed in the 2020 budget through a Police Services Board group purchasing effort
- Council received a design concept for the exterior courtyard space of the Asphodel-Norwood Public Library (Norwood branch) through the Rural Economic Development (RED) Funding project
- Council adopted the Telecommunication Tower Policy
- Council authorized the Mayor and Clerk to enter into a Pre-Servicing Agreement with DPH Developments for Norwood Park Phase 3 with the passing of By-law 2020-24
- Council supported the municipal resolution to request the province to review the Farm Property Class Tax Rate program
- CAO/Clerk/Treasurer, Candice White, gave a COVID-19 update on municipal operations, the financial audit, and Township reopening plans/policies under review by the Municipal Control Group
- Council confirmed the location of the sign placement recognizing the 200th Anniversary for the Township of Asphodel as Westwood Park
