

Tuesday June 22, 2021

- Council received recruitment results for the following positions:
 - Manager of Public Works and Environmental Services; and
 - Operations Lead Hand in the Parks, Recreation, and Facilities Department (*NEW position)
- Chris Kawalec, Community Development Program Manager for the City of Peterborough presented Council with an [Interim Report](#) for the regional Community Safety and Well-Being plan;
- Council supported a request for the Solicitor General to waive the 2021 requirement for an emergency exercise;
- Council approved the use of telephone and internet voting for the 2022 Municipal Election;
- Council directed staff to amend the Parks and Facilities By-law (By-law 2019-49 - as amended) to remove subsection 4.c.a. (Swimming) and 4.c.b. (Fishing) from the list of General Prohibited Activities (Part 2);
- Council authorized the Mayor and Clerk to execute the following agreements:
 - Development Agreement with Dianne M. Loyst (Indian River Reptile Zoo aka Canada's Dinosaur Park); and
 - Peer Review Agreement with DPH Developments Inc. for an Official Plan Amendment Application for a proposed Norwood Park Phase 4;
- Council entered into a Public Meeting at 2:00 p.m. to consider an Official Plan Amendment Application and a Zoning By-law Amendment Application for Pt Lots 17 and 18, Concession 9 within the settlement area of Norwood that would allow for a potential residential intensification of these lands;
- Doug Griffiths, best-selling author of 13 Ways to Kill Your Community will be speaking at the Community Futures Peterborough [AGM](#) on Thursday June 24, 2021 from 8:15-10:30 a.m.; and
- Mayor Bonneau commended Peterborough Public Health and Township Staff for a successful second-dose pop-up clinic held at the Asphodel-Norwood Community Centre earlier in the day.
