

Monday July 13, 2020

- Council amended the [Parks & Facilities By-Law \(2019-49\)](#) and the [Regulation of Traffic and Parking By-Law \(2017-05\)](#) to address the growing number of concerns related to Public Access Points for the Trent River;
- Council supported the Condominium Application for the properties known as Blocks 24 and 25 Maple Avenue, approving the Draft Plan Conditions for staff to forward onto Peterborough County for next steps;
- Council authorized the Mayor and Clerk to enter into a contribution agreement for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) Rural and Northern Stream as represented by the Ministry of Agriculture, Food, and Rural Affairs for the reconstruction of Centre Line Road with the passing of By-Law 2020-30;
- Council approved the recommended amendments to the Site Plan Control Area By-law to bring cannabis production activities into Site Plan Control and update the definition of a multi-dwelling unit to no greater than six with the passing of By-Law 2020-31; and
- Council authorized the Mayor and Clerk to execute a Site Plan Approval for the property known as 11 Albine Street.
