



Township of Asphodel-Norwood Council Meeting Highlights

Tuesday September 10, 2019

- Recruitment results were shared for winter position vacancies at the Community Centre
- Council received a risk assessment and review of the Drinking Water Quality Management Standard (DWQMS) in accordance with the Safe Drinking Water Act
- Council passed a Parks & Facilities By-law to regulate and promote responsible, shared used, and enjoyment of parks and related facilities in the Township
- Council approved a Customer Service Policy
- Council approved the 2020 Municipal Operating and Capital Budget schedule- Staff will start presenting department budgets at the October 15 Council meeting – the adoption of the budget is scheduled for January 14, 2020
- Staff reviewed the Management Action List with Council for the remaining six meetings of Council for 2019
- Council supported the Norwood Agricultural Society's request for use of Township property to operate helicopter rides at the 2019 Norwood Fall Fair
- Staff advised the Township is in the final stages of developing their new brand. A survey launched September 9, 2019 giving residents' logo and tagline options to vote upon until September 30, 2019
- The warrantied water meter replacement program will commence the week of Monday October 21, 2019
- A maple tree donated by ORCA will be placed during a tree planting ceremony to be held at the Mill Pond Park on September 24, 2019 at 12:15 p.m.
- A plaque unveiling ceremony will be held at Norwood Park to honour tree sponsors on September 24, 2019 at 6:30 p.m
- Council nominated Deputy Mayor Burt for the vacant municipal representative position on the Trent Conservation Coalition Source Protection Committee
