

## THE TOWNSHIP OF ASPHODEL NORWOOD SUMMARY REPORT FOR THE NORWOOD DRINKING WATER SYSTEM

### Report

This report is a summary of water quality information for the Norwood Drinking Water System published in accordance with Schedule 22 of Ontario's Drinking-Water Systems Regulation for the reporting period of January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024. The Norwood Drinking Water System is categorized as a Large Municipal Residential Drinking Water System. This report was prepared for the Township of Asphodel-Norwood.

### Who gets a copy of the Report?

- in the case of a drinking-water system owned by a municipality, the members of the municipal Council;
- in the case of a drinking-water system owned by a municipal service board established under section 195 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, the members of the municipal service board; or
- in the case of a drinking-water system owned by a corporation, the board of directors of the corporation.

### What must the Report contain?

The report must,

- (a) list the requirements of the Act, the regulations, the system's approval, drinking water works permit, municipal drinking water license and any orders applicable to the system that were not met at any time during the period covered by the report; and
- (b) For each requirement referred to in clause (a) that was not met, specify the duration of the failure and the measures that were taken to correct the failure.

**What else must the Report contain?**

The report must also include the following information for the purpose of enabling the owner of the system to assess the capability of the system to meet existing and planned uses of the system:

1. A summary of the quantities and flow rates of the water supplied during the period covered by the report, including monthly average and maximum daily flows.
2. A comparison of the summary referred to in paragraph 1 to the rated capacity and flow rates approved in the system's approval, drinking water works permit or municipal drinking water license.

**When Does the Report Get Submitted?**

If a report is prepared for a system that supplies water to a municipality, the owner of the system shall give a copy of the report to the municipality by March 31 the following year.
