



The Township introduced themed public skating this quarter with the incentive for participants to win one of three \$10 canteen / participating vendor vouchers!









Spotlight on Council

In the 4th Quarter, Council considered and/or made the following decisions:

 Authorizes Drain Bros. Ltd to complete the scope of work for the Highway No. 7 asphalt repair following a water service leak

 Awarded the group purchasing tender for the supply, delivery, mix, and stockpile of Winter Sand to Drain Bros. Excavation Limited for the 2022/2023 winter season

 Approved the 2023 Employee Benefit Renewal Package, as included in the Peterborough County-Wide Program managed by Mosey & Mosey Benefit Plan Consultants

 Entered into a Transfer Payment Agreement with the federal/provincial Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program – Green Stream for the replacement of the Village of Norwood’s Standpipe

 Received Inspection Results from the Ministry of Environment Conservation and Parks for the Norwood Drinking Water System and Trentview Estates Distribution System with favourable results

 Entered into an agreement for the proposed Albine St. extension (as a condition of consent approval for the proposed 4th phase of Norwood Park)

 Adopted a new Dog Control By-law (no. 2022-48) to better address Livestock Guardian Dogs and Herding Dogs

 Received an update on the Westwood Library Well, including a Groundwater Assessment Report and Technical Memo from D.M. Wills Associates Ltd.

 Set the 2023 Council meeting schedule and 2023 Township Office closure dates

 Adopted updated Terms of Reference guide materials for the Township's Cemetery Board, Cultural & Heritage Committee, Library Board, Police Services Board, Special Events Committee, and Trails Committee.

 Approved the installation of a temporary Outdoor Skating Rink to be located in the J.J. Stewart Ball Field with the understanding that a volunteer community group will oversee operations and maintenance

 Supported a Wireless Communications Site at 13 Birdsall Lane, Hastings through Rogers Communications Inc.

 Adopted an ATV/ORV By-law. Please see antownship.ca/offroadvehicles for full details

 Approved the 2023 Municipal Insurance Renewal proposal through Marsh Canada Limited

 Adopted the A-N Transfer Station Design and Operations Plan/Closure Plan

 Approved an allocation of \$35,000 for necessary grader repairs
