Reconstruction News

As you know, it's going to be a busy construction season all around the Township. We want to draw your attention in particular to the County Road 40 reconstruction project.

Residents are advised that the County Road 40 Reconstruction Project (from Wellington Street to Albine Street) is scheduled to begin June 29, 2026, and will require a full road closure for approximately six (6) weeks. The roadway is expected to reopen mid-August, weather permitting.

Site preparation activities may begin in advance of the construction start date.

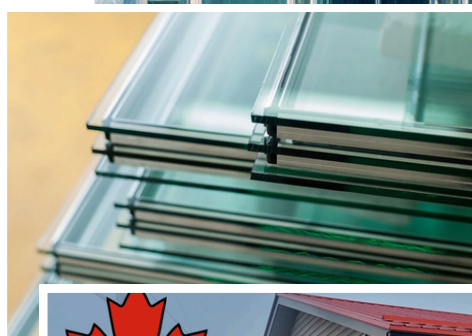
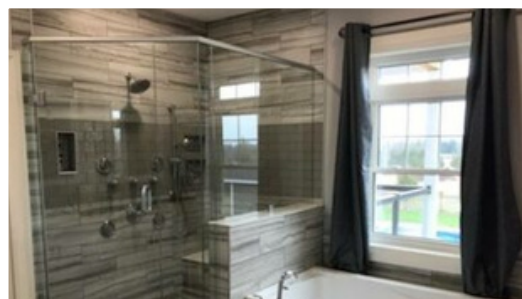
